- A7.5 VHF Ch.73 will be used during the Race for changes i.e Shortened Course
- A7.6 The Start/Finish line will be deemed a Gate. Times recorded at the Start/Finish may be used as Finish times

A8 Finish

- A8.1 If a race official is not available to record finishing and first lap times, entrants will be advised prior to the race start to record their own times and post to the WhatsApp Group "BSC Friday Afternoon Series"
