EVENT APPENDIX

To be read in conjunction with the 2026 Interclub Challenge Sailing Instructions published by the Cruising Yacht Club of Australia.

2 COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the NCYC event webpage – <https://www.ncyc.net.au/inshore-racing/interclub-challenge/>
- 2.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagstaff located on top of the floating shed on F-arm of the marina.

3 BOATS SUPPLIED BY THE ORGANISING AUTHORITY

- 3.1 Eight (8) Elliott 6m yachts will be supplied.

4 DAMAGE AND REPAIRS TO BOATS

- 4.1 Each team shall complete the Return Log upon coming ashore at the end of the day's racing specifying any damage or loss or confirming that there is no damage or loss.

The return log shall be submitted by scanning the QR code displayed on the Elliott.

6 RACING AREA

- 6.1 The intended racing area will be in the vicinity of Honeysuckle Hotel, in the Basin of Newcastle Harbour.

8 MARKS

- 8.1 Marks 1, 1a and the Gate marks will be blue buoys.
- 8.2 The Start/Finish Mark will be a pink buoy.

9 START LINE

- 9.3 The Warning Signal will be the Elliott Class insignia on a white background.

23 MEDIA RIGHTS AND RESTRICTIONS

- 23.1 The conditions of entry include that competitors acknowledge that the Organising Authority owns all media rights to the event and may exercise those rights as it sees fit and that the Organising Authority has the unconditional perpetual right to publish and broadcast, for any purpose and in any media, photographs and video and audio recordings taken of boats and competitors during the event.
